In lieu of flowers, the family requests that donations be made the American Cancer Society / Breast Cancer in honor of Koula Litras.






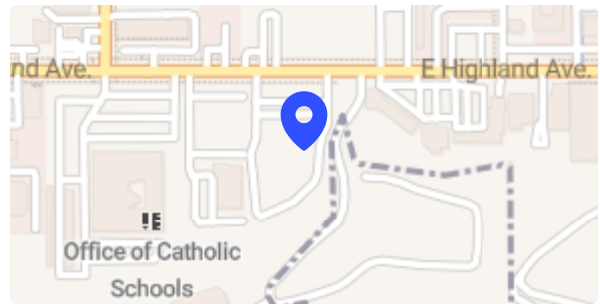

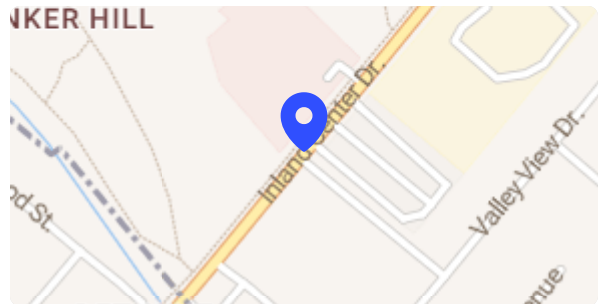

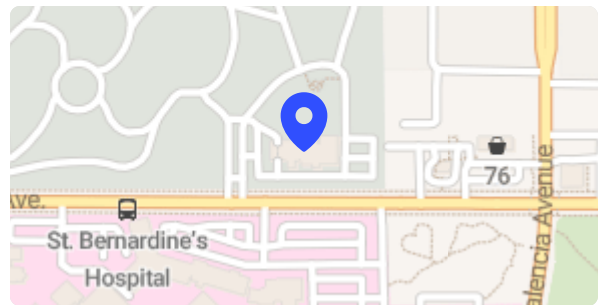
