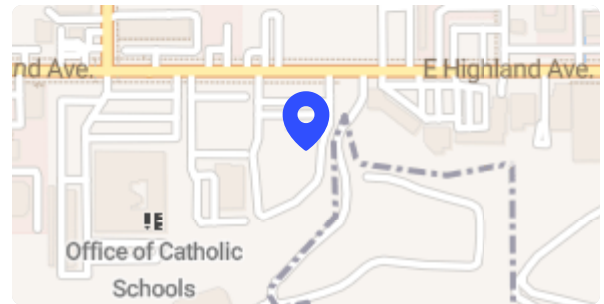

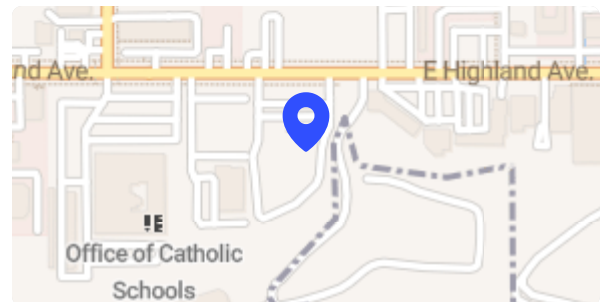


Rosary

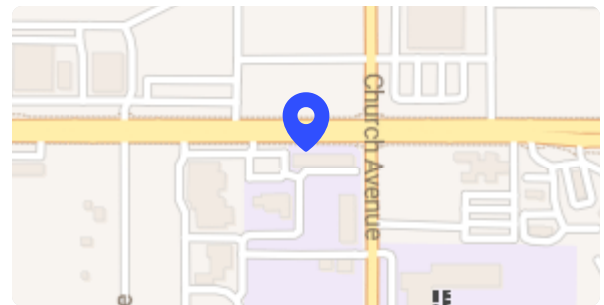


Mass of Christian Burial

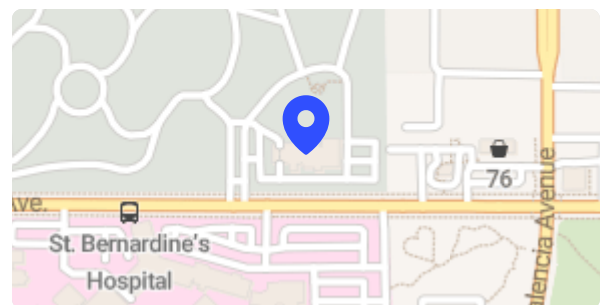
