A reception will follow Mass in the hall.



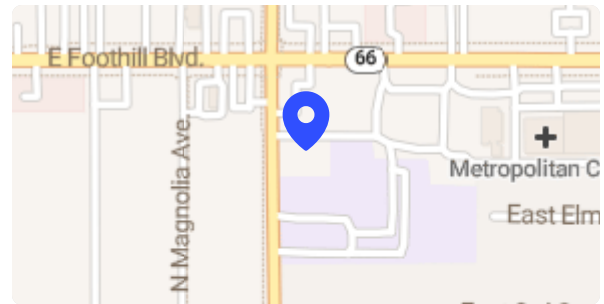
