Graveside is private.

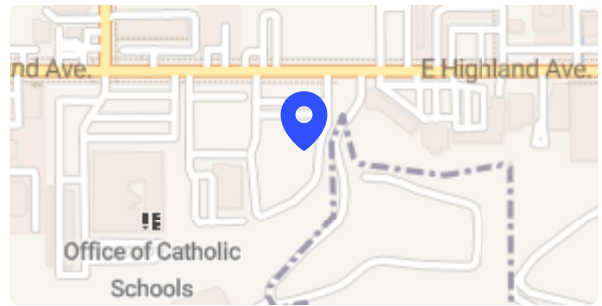
