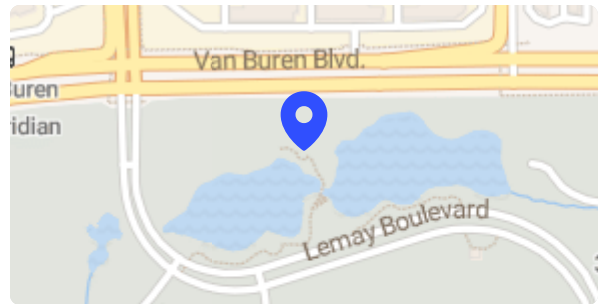
JUN 16, 1929 - JUN 19, 2016

She served the Lord as a Missionary along side of her husband, Myron "Mike" Perl since 1955. They were the founders of the Hebrew Christian Witness, a mission to the Jewish people. She was a Bible scholar and teacher of hundreds of Bible classes and countless students. 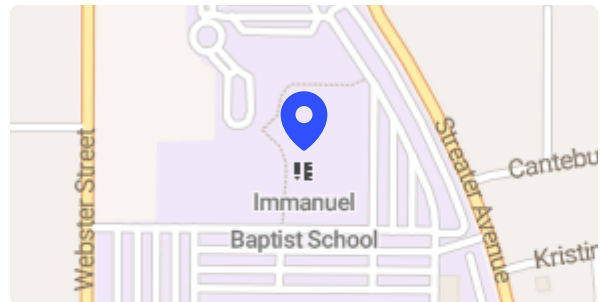
