Charles enjoyed working, helping people, visiting with friends and family as well as being the biggest cheerleader when following his children's activities.

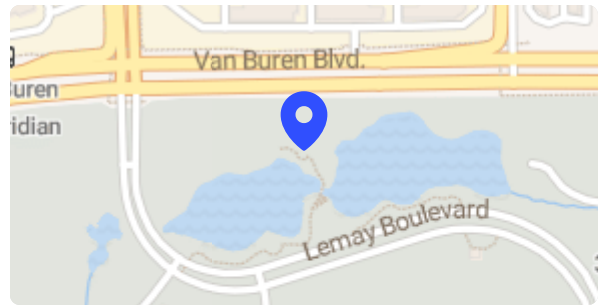
