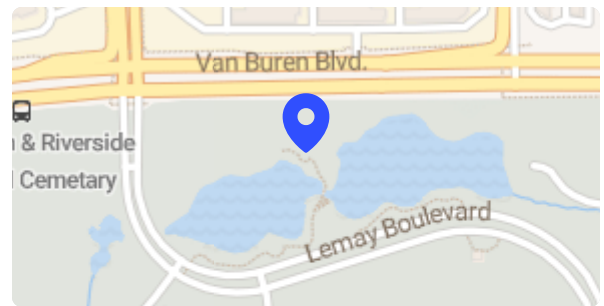
MAR 23, 1945 - SEP 5, 2017

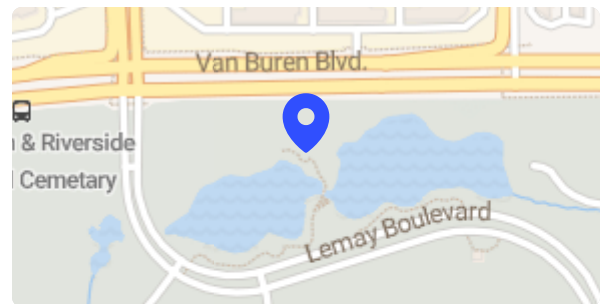
