ALEXANDER JAMES MOLINA, 82 years, died at the Jerry L. Pettis Veterans Hospital in Loma Linda, CA, on Tuesday, September 5, 2006. He was born in Los Angeles on October 27, 1923. On August 30, 1945 he married his high school sweetheart, Alice Bañuelos. In 1970 he moved to Twin Peaks.
