It was depression time, and jobs were hard to come by, but she was able to work as a kindergarten teacher in San Bernardino. It was there she met and married Kenneth C. Bussey in 1937. They lived in many southern California cities during the war years and their 3 children (Ann, Ken and Nancy) were born before they returned to San Bernardino in 1945. A 60-year member of San Bernardino Assistance League, Kay enjoyed travel, crossword puzzles, music, playing the piano (by ear) and summer on Balboa Island with her family. Kay also enjoyed daily walks, her scripture class and especially her grandchildren and great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her daughter Nancy Moughan (Terry) in 1994, and her husband Kenneth Bussey in 2000.
