Gary Lisk of Highland, passed away on December 24, 2007 at the age of 60 in the Sequoia National Park. Born in Albuquerque, New Mexico, Gary lived in San Bernardino County for the past 36 years where he worked as an Orthopedic Physician's Assistant at St. Bernardine's Medical Center.
