KENNETH A. CORNELIUS, 88, OF HIGHLAND PASSED AWAY SATURDAY AT HIS HOME. BORN IN LITTLE CHUTE, WI, MR CORNELIUS CAME TO RIVERSIDE IN 1942 AND THEN TO HIGHLAND IN 1986. MR. CORNELIUS SERVED IN THE US ARMY DURING WORLD WAR II AND CONTINUED HIS CIVIL SERVICE AS A CONTRACT NEGOTIATOR AT NORTON AIR FORCE BASE FOR 23 YEARS RETIRING IN 1955. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE MASON LODGE #178, SCOTTISH RITE, AL MALAIKAH TEMPLE,, SAN BERNARDINO SHRINE CLUB, HIGH TWELVE CLUB #430, THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, THE N.A.R.F.E CHAPTER #73, AND WAS A MEMBER OF THE SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY GRAND JURY FROM 1991-1992. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE OF 23 YEARS , LAURA JUNE, DAUGHTER LINDA HICKLE OF NUEVO, 2 GRANDSONS, SCOTT AND JEFF MINESINGER AND SEVERAL GREAT GRANDCHILDREN AND 3 STEP CHILDREN.
