Augustine "Telin" Guisa, 70, of Highland CA, went to be with his Lord on Thursday, November 9th, 2017. He passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones at Kaiser Hospital, Baldwin Park.

He leaves behind his longtime companion, Juanita Arriaga; his sons Augustine Guisa Jr and Steven Guisa and his wife Amy; his daughters Kelly O'Brien and Holly Evers and her husband Mathew; Brother Manuel Guisa and sisters Noni Jimenez and Jessie Lopez; 8 grandchildren and one great grandchild; and his dog Minnie.
