Marie went to work for the County of San Bernardino in 1962. She was the first Hispanic Woman to reach the position all the way to the top as a Director. Her responsibilities were to oversee all of the construction and maintenance of all the County's buildings and facilities, including Hospitals and Court Houses.

Marie served as a member of the Board of Directors for Arrowhead Credit Union. She served as Chairman of the Board of that organization for several years and was well respected in the credit union industry. Marie served on many civic and industry organizations. She was recognized many times for her work and involvement by many groups including federal, state and local government.

Marie enjoyed life to the fullest and was fortunate to travel the world with her beloved husband Alex. She enjoyed time with family, friends and colleagues while always maintaining a spirit of love. She will be missed by all who knew her. She is survived by her husband Alex M. Alonzo, and brother Steve Nava, both residents of San Bernardino.
